

Jail And Prison Rehabilitation Information (JAPRI) Community Outreach Program

Vital Statistics

- Over 11 million adults in nation's criminal justice system.
- Approximately two-thirds of those released from jail or prison will re-enter within 3 years.
- Approximately 58% Black, 32% Hispanic, and 21% White children live in single parent homes.
- About 36% of all children live without a father in the home.

Goals of JAPRI

- To assist in the rehabilitation of males that have been in jail or prison;
- To decrease the recidivism rate for males having been incarcerated;
- Help develop good fathers; and
- Help target demographic group receive further education, employment and/or drug treatment.

Target Demographic Group

- Minority male juveniles who have fathered a child seeking support in being a good father;
- Minority males at risk of committing a crime that could lead to incarceration; and
- Minority males that have been incarcerated and seeking rehabilitation at the grass roots level.

How to Get Started

- Courts and community referrals;
- Male self-identification; and
- Website inquiry.

What's In It For Participants

- Job preparation training;
- Men training men on how to become a good father;
- Becoming a positive factor in the home, work, and community;
- Addressing educational limitations, alcohol and drug addiction, environmental and general health issues; and
- Certificate of Completion.
